


# **DESCRIPTION/ORDERING INFORMATION**

This single 2-input positive-NOR gate is operational at 0.8-V to 2.7-V V<sub>CC</sub>, but is designed specifically for 1.65-V to 1.95-V  $V_{CC}$  operation.

The SN74AUC1G02 performs the Boolean function  $Y = \overline{A + B}$  or  $Y = \overline{A + B}$  in positive logic.

NanoFree™ package technology is a major breakthrough in IC packaging concepts, using the die as the package.

This device is fully specified for partial-power-down applications using I<sub>off</sub>. The I<sub>off</sub> circuitry disables the outputs, preventing damaging current backflow through the device when it is powered down.





PLASTIC SMALL-OUTLINE PACKAGE

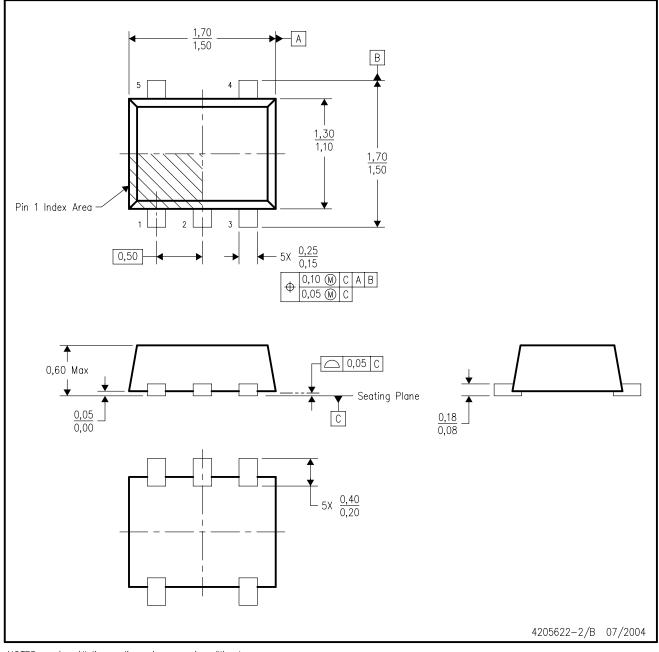

# PLASTIC SMALL OUTLINE




