
# LM317AHV 3-Terminal Positive Adjustable Regulator

### **Features**

- Output Current in Excess of 1.5 A
- Output Adjustable Between 1.2 V and 57 V
- Internal Thermal Overload Protection
- · Internal Short-Circuit Current Limiting
- Output Transistor Safe Area Compensation

## **Description**

This monolithic integrated circuit is an adjustable 3-terminal positive voltage regulator designed to supply more than 1.5 A of load current with an output voltage adjustable over a 1.2 V to 57 V. It employs internal current limiting, thermal shut down and safe area compensation.

## **Block Diagram**




Figure 1. Block Diagram

## **Absolute Maximum Ratings**

### Notes:

- 1. Load and line regulation are specified at constant junction temperature. Change in  $V_D$  due to heating effects must be taken into account separately. Pulse testing with low duty is used. ( $P_{MAX} = 20 \text{ W}$ )
- 2. C<sub>ADJ</sub>, when used, is connected between the adjustment pin and ground.




Figure 2. Load Regulation




Figure 4. Dropout Voltage




Figure 3. Adjustment Current





Figure 5. Reference Voltage




 $V_0 = 1.25V (1 + R_2/R_1) + I_{adj}R_2$

### Note:

3.  $C_i$  is required when regulator is located an appreciable distance from power supply filter.  $C_o$  is not needed for stability, however, it does improve transient response. Since  $I_{ADJ}$  is controlled to less than 100  $\mu$ A, the error associated with this term is negligible in most applications.







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
