

TinyLogic UHS Dual Inverter with Schmitt Trigger Inputs

NC7WZ14

Description

The NC7WZ14 is a dual inverter with Schmitt trigger input from onsemi's Ultra-High Speed (UHS) Series of TinyLogic. The device is fabricated with advanced CMOS technology to achieve ultra-high speed with high output drive while maintaining low static power dissipation over a very broad V_{CC} operating range. The device is specified to operate over the 1.65 V to 5.5 V V_{CC} range. The inputs and outputs are high-impedance when V_{CC} is 0 V. Inputs tolerate voltages up to 5.5 V independent of V_{CC} operating voltage. Schmitt trigger inputs achieve typically 1 V hysteresis between the positive-and negative-going input threshold voltage at 5 V.





Figure 1. Logic Symbol




Figure 2. SC-88 (Top View)





Figure 3. MicroPak (Top Through View)



Figure 5. AC Test Circuit





Figure 6. AC Waveforms

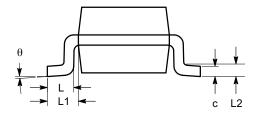


TOP VIEW
